Francesca Caccini's *Il primo libro delle musiche* of 1618 The Guitar in Stuart England Performance on

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francesca caccini 1587 ca 1640 was an accomplished composer singer and instrumentalist in the tradition of the florentine camerata her 1618 volume *il primo libro delle musiche* was dedicated to her patron the cardinal de medici 1596 1666 this modern critical edition presents 17 secular monodies for one and two voices with figured bass accompaniment from this landmark collection the book includes text translations biographical and stylistic essays recommendations on performance practice and other commentary

the guitar is the most played instrument in the west this is the first account of its rise in stuart england

the first book length study in any language dedicated specifically to lute guitar and vihuela

in compiling this landmark sourcebook finnish guitarists hannu annala and heiki matlik consulted more than 70 music texts as well as dozens of composer resumes acquired from the musical information centers of several countries during the writing process which lasted for more than three years they received additional information from many modern composers including leo brouwer and reginald smith brindle among others in addition several internationally renowned performing guitarists provided valuable information these include magnus andersson sweden remi boucher canada margarita escarpa spain aleksander frauchi russia and david tanenbaum usa among others the authors aim was to write a well structured book with separate chapters for each instrument such as the renaissance and baroque guitar the renaissance and baroque lute the vihuela etc this unique structure enables the reader to easily discover which composers wrote for a certain instrument during any given period in addition to the composers one would expect to find in such a comprehensive listing the book documents several historical and modern composers for whom little previous information has been available the book s list of more than 400 guitar and lute concertos dating from the baroque era to the present day is a totally unprecedented short introductions regarding guitar and lute like instruments as well as their basic histories are provided at the beginning of the book the authors hope that the handbook of guitar and lute composers will serve as a practical guide for both amateurs and professionals encouraging further study of the history of these instruments and expanding the repertoire heard on today s concert stage

more than twenty years ago james tyler wrote a modest introduction to the history repertory and playing techniques of the four and five course guitar entitled *the early guitar a history and handbook* oup 1980 this work proved valuable and enlightening not only to performers and scholars of renaissance and baroque guitar and lute music but also to classical guitarists this new book written in collaboration with paul sparks their previous book for oup *the early mandolin* appeared in 1989

presents new ideas and research on the history and development of the guitar and its music from the renaissance to the dawn of the classical era tyler s systematic study of the two main guitar types found between about 1550 and 1750 focuses principally on what the sources of the music published and manuscript and the writings of contemporary theorists reveal about the nature of the instruments and their roles in the music making of the period the annotated lists of primary sources previously published in the early guitar but now revised and expanded constitute the most comprehensive bibliography of baroque guitar music to date his appendices of performance practice information should also prove indispensable to performers and scholars alike paul sparks also breaks new ground offering an extensive study of a period in the guitar s history notably c 1759 c 1800 which the standard histories usually dismiss in a few short paragraphs far from being a dormant instrument at this time the guitar is shown to have been central to music making in france italy the iberian peninsula and south america sparks provides a wealth of information about players composers instruments and surviving compositions from this neglected but important period and he examines how the five course guitar gradually gave way to the six string instrument a process that occurred in very different ways and at different times in france italy spain germany and britain

baroque music not long ago considered the province of the specialist now occupies a central place in the interests of any music lover not just bach and handel but vivaldi and monteverdi couperin and rameau purcell and schütz are familiar and loved figures there is place now for a survey that offers fresh perspectives on these men and the times in which they lived that is what the companion to baroque music is designed to offer to all those who are attracted by the music of that crucial century and a half 1600 1750 which we call the baroque era julie anne sadie herself scholar performer and critic brings to this survey two novel features first it is underpinned by a keen awareness of music as sound intended to be played heard and relished by the listener as witness the group of articles contributed by well known specialists such as nigel rogers and david fuller on the central issues of performance secondly it is concerned not only with what the music is like but why it is as it is and the series of essays again by specialists such as michael talbot on italy and peter holman on england which places each region s music in its social and cultural contexts helps to explain its character the

A History of Baroque Music is a detailed treatment of the music of the Baroque era with particular focus on the seventeenth century the author's approach is a history of musical style with an emphasis on musical scores the book is divided initially by time period into early and later Baroque 1600-1700 and 1700-1750 respectively and secondarily by country and composer an introductory chapter discusses stylistic continuity with the late Renaissance and examines the etymology of the term Baroque the concluding chapter on the composer Telemann addresses the stylistic shift that led to the end of the Baroque and the transition into the Classical period jacket
